English

In English this term we will be exploring the book *A Natural History of Magical Beasts* to inspire our own non-chronological reports followed by various texts to explore diary writing.

In reading sessions, we will be continuing with *Kensuke's Kingdom* before focusing on the poems *The listeners* by Walter De La Mare and *Firework Night* by Enid Blyton



Geography

Rivers – This term we will be exploring different rivers around the UK and the world using a variety of maps and atlases. We will also find out how rivers are formed, the part they play in the water cycle, the effects of erosion and how they are used.

Maths

We will start this term by focusing on fractions: identifying fractions, ordering fractions and adding and multiplying fractions. We will then move on to work based around shape and position. We will also continue to develop our times tables knowledge and mental strategies.

Science

Electricity – In this topic the children will develop their knowledge and understanding of how electricity works as well as drawing, creating and problem solving with electrical circuits.

French

This term we will continuing to develop our language around numbers and school life as well as exploring Christmas vocab and traditions.

Music

This term we will be practicing our music reading by leaning Christmas songs on the glockenspiels as well as exploring our new Musician and the Month.
