

English

This term we will be using the book 'Traction Man is Here!' by Mini Grey to learn about nouns and adjectives in our sentence work. In the second part of the term we become more festive and will be using a beautiful Christmas book to inspire our writing. We will also be doing small group guided reading sessions, alongside listening to the children read individually every day.

DT

Sewing – this term the children will be using bespoke workbooks to investigate, design, make, create and evaluate a Christmas decoration. They will learn some sewing techniques and have a decoration to bring home for the tree!

Maths

This term will continue with number and place value – we will be reading and writing numbers to 100, ordering forwards and backwards and using a number line. We will also continue to learn our times tables for this year, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Then we will move onto addition and subtraction, using part whole models and cementing our knowledge of number bonds.

P.E will be happening on Monday afternoons with Mrs Coe and Thursday afternoons with the sports coaches so please make sure your child comes in their full kit on these days. It is helpful to have spare socks in case of wet weather!



Science
